NOTICE:

- Targeting garages, shed, stables, containers, barns and outbuildings on industrial yards, farms, isolated residential properties and sports clubs in rural locations.
- Using a variety of methods to damage perimeter fences to gain access to locations.
- Break locks/cut fences/force doors.
- Power tools, trade tools, horse tack, metal and quad bikes targeted.
- Targeting motor vehicles parked in rural car parks for various items on display.
- Theft of tools from vans parked in isolated areas where MOE is to smash

- windows.
- Theft of diesel from lorries parked on slip roads, specifically the Ripley Bypass.
